Gerald "Bud" Burgwin, 87, of Syracuse, passed away Monday, April 1, 2013 at Crouse Hospital surrounded by his loving family. He was born on June 2, 1925 in Quincy, Massachusetts. Bud was a WWII Navy veteran. He grew up on the North side and was a communicant of St. John the Baptist Church and later St. Peter's Church. Bud was the owner and operator of his own service station "Bud's Gulf" for most of his working years and later retired from Onondaga County. Throughout his life, he was an avid bowler and softball player until the age of 83. Bud played second base for the Senior Cyclones Softball World Series Championship Team of 2000. Anyone who knew Bud, knew that he was a devoted New York Yankees fan until the very end.

He is survived by his loving wife of 61 years, Frances (Scripa) Burgwin; six children, LouAnn (Jim) Darlington, Michael (Julie) Burgwin, Steven (Karen) Burgwin, Jerry (MarySue) Burgwin, Diane (George) Moon and Mark (Jamie) Burgwin; thirteen grandchildren, a sister, Betty Cavelli; a sister-in-law, Mary Burgwin and several nieces and nephews.

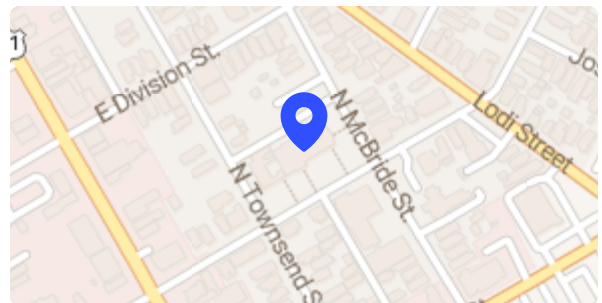

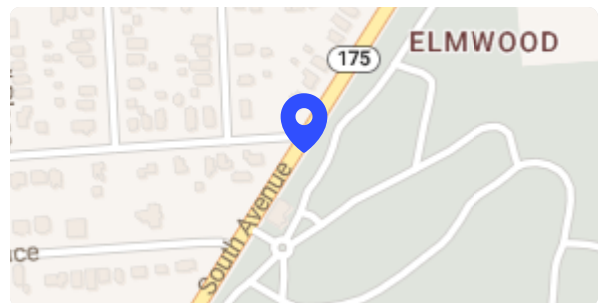

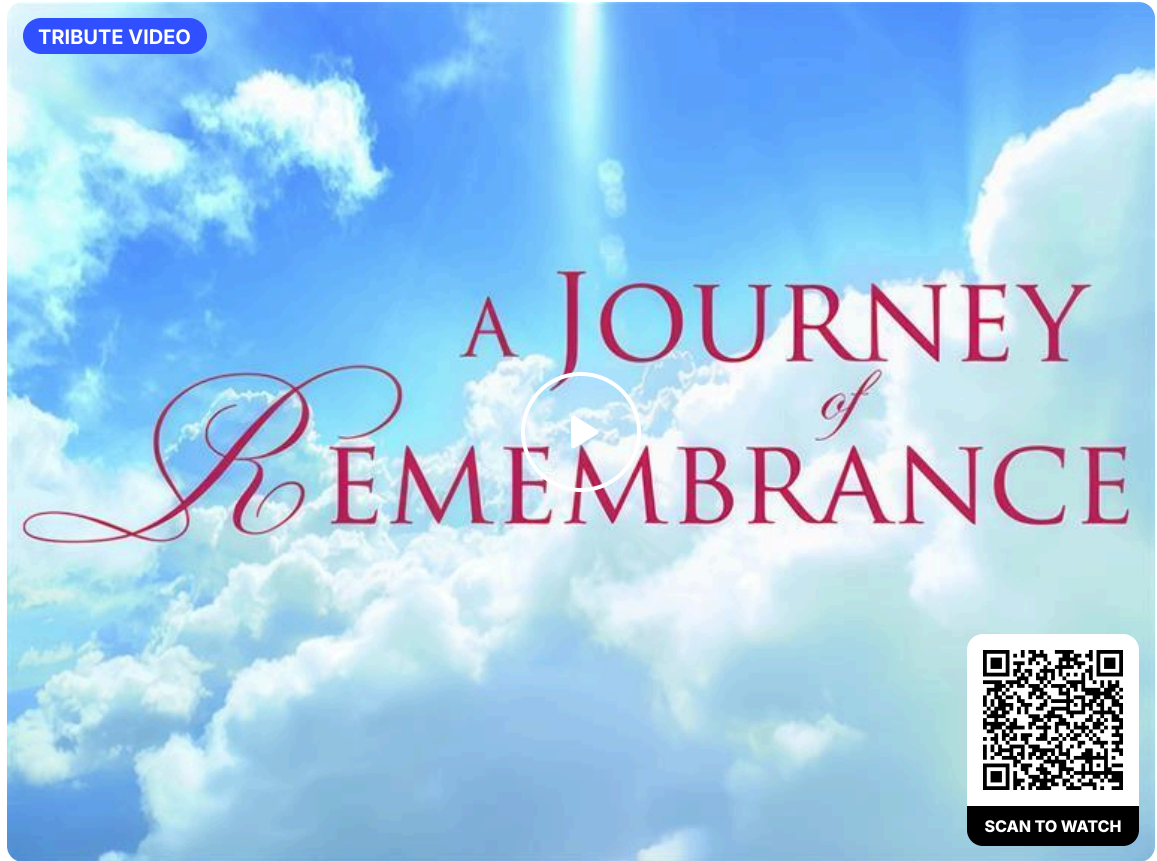
