## Palma Spensieri

SEP 3, 1916 - APR 14, 2013

**P**alma (Pisani) Spensieri, 96, of Syracuse, passed away Sunday, April 14, 2013 at Van Duyn Home & Hospital. She was born in Syracuse, the daughter of the late James V. and Dolores (Sacco) Pisani. Palma worked at Learbury's for over 45 years as a seamstress and was a member of the Amalgamated Clothing Workers Union. She was a communicant of Our Lady of Pompei/St. Peter Church and a member of St. Theresa's Society. Palma also volunteered at the Thrift Shop of St. Joseph's Hospital. 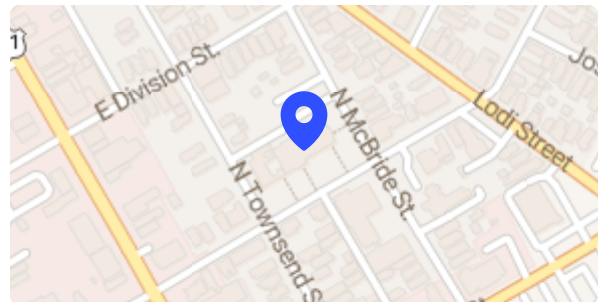

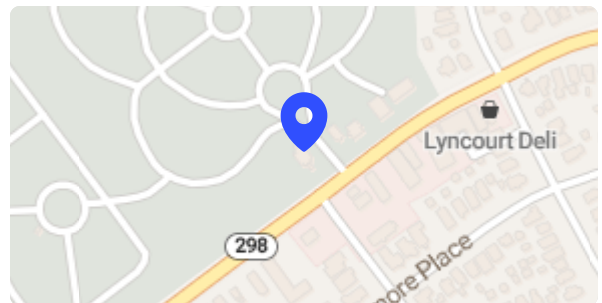
