Anthony "Tony" Aloï, 87, of Cicero, passed away Tuesday at St. Joseph's Hospital. He was born in Syracuse and was a graduate of Eastwood High School and Central City Business Institute. Tony served in the U.S. Navy during WWII and Korea, on the USS Oak Hill and USS Mayo. He was an Inspector with Carrier Corporation for 35 years, retiring in 1988. Tony was a volunteer fireman in Jamesville and was a member of the American Legion North Syracuse Post 5988. He was an avid Yankee fan and enjoyed golfing, bowling, fishing and dancing at the "Lace Club". Tony's greatest enjoyment was spending time with his family and grandchildren.
