Olga's family would like to thank the staff of Loretto Cunningham, 6th floor, especially to Heather, Lucretia and Patty for their loving care they gave to Olga.



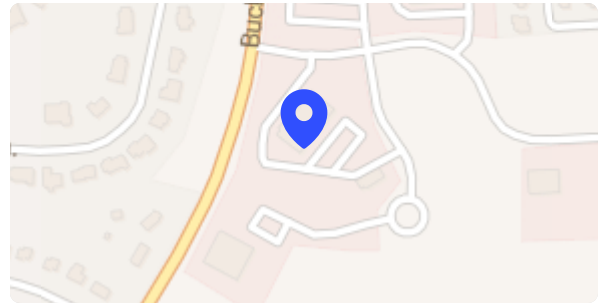

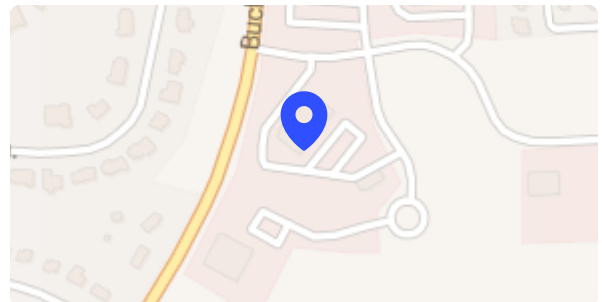

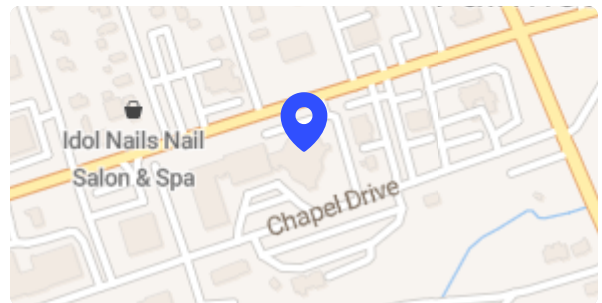
