William E. "Bill" White Jr., 90, of Liverpool, passed away peacefully Saturday at home at Greenpoint. He was born in Oneida, NY, the son of William E. White Sr. and Theresa (Fox) White. After the Japanese invasion of Pearl Harbor, William enlisted in the U.S. Army to serve his country and was stationed in the Pacific throughout WWII. William returned to Oneida, met Helen, graduated from Le Moyne College and together they settled in Camillus where they raised their family. He retired from the Internal Revenue Service after 30 years and went to work for the governments of Guam and the Virgin Islands. Bill and Helen loved to travel and these jobs allowed them to see that much more of the world.

He was predeceased by his sister, Catherine Bowe and brothers-in-law, Fr. Frank Menard, John Bowe, and Gene Bourdan. William is survived by his loving wife of 61 years, Helen (Menard) White; his daughter, Karen White (Anthony Sgroi) of Liverpool; his son, William "Billy" White of Cleveland, NY and his daughters, Addie and Mackenzie; sisters, Mary Donahue of Oneida, NY and Sr. M. 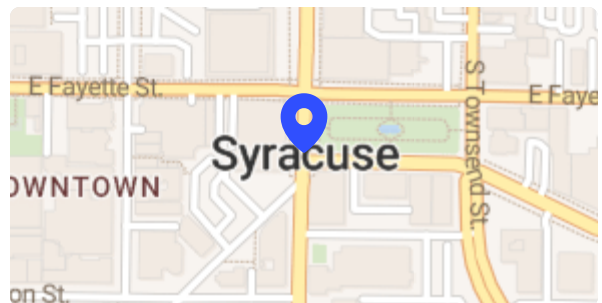

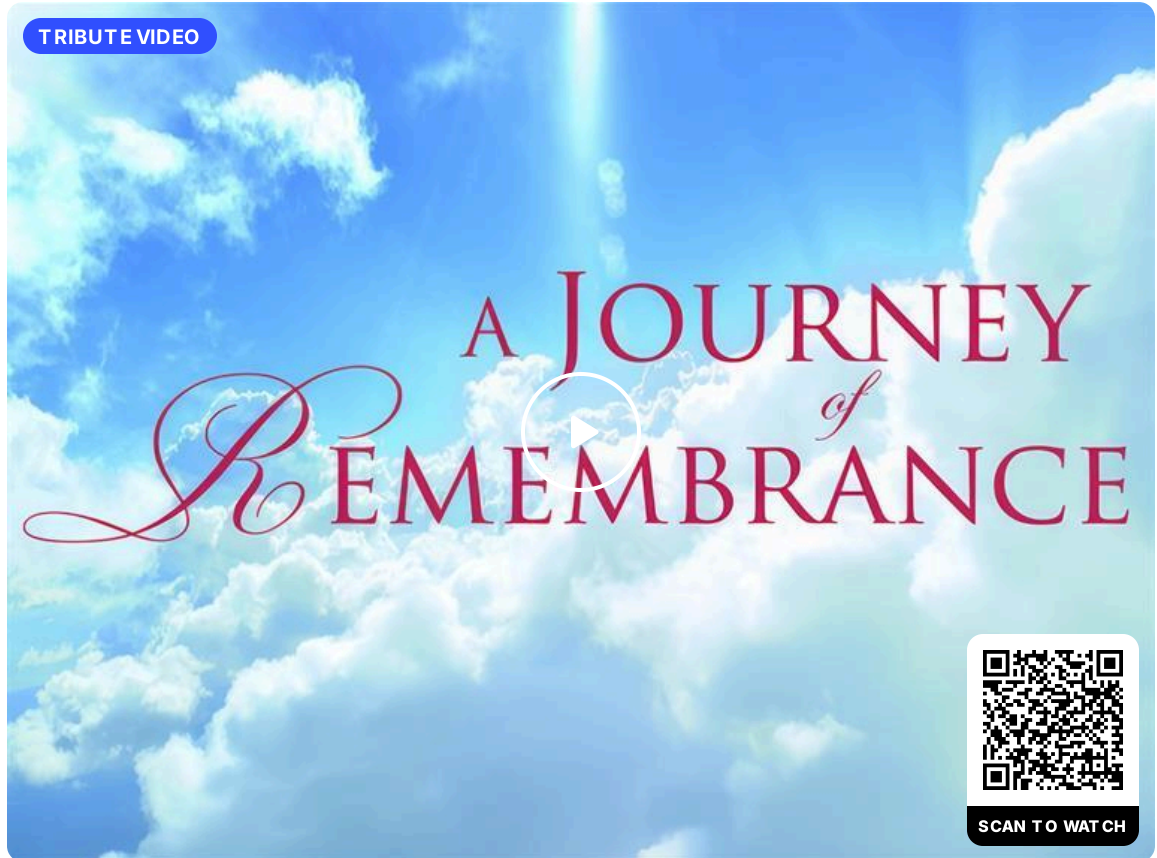
