Rose (Cardarelli) Stagnitta, 86, of Liverpool, passed away peacefully on Thursday at St. Joseph's Hospital. She was born in Syracuse, the daughter of the late Antonio and Loretta (DeMarcs) Cardarelli. Rose was a graduate of North High School and received overseas orders for Carrier Corporation, retiring after 40 years of service.
