Ronald F. Fowler, Sr., 76, of Cicero, passed away on Sunday surrounded by his loving family. He was born in Syracuse and served 8 years with the US Navy during the Korean War. Ron was a member of the American Legion Cicero Post 0787 and long standing member of the UAW. He was an avid Ham Radio Operator and owner/operator of Home Video Service. Ron was a member of Sacred Heart Church in Cicero and had a deep, strong faith and devotion to God. Those that had the privilege of knowing Ron will remember him for his strong love and life-long dedication to providing for his family. He had a close bond to his friends, compassion for all of God's creatures and very proud of "his Navy". Ron retired from New Process Gear in 1998 after 30 years of service. 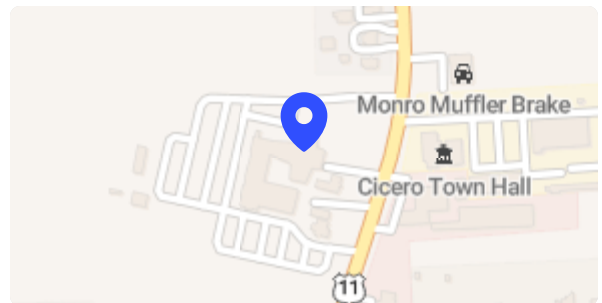

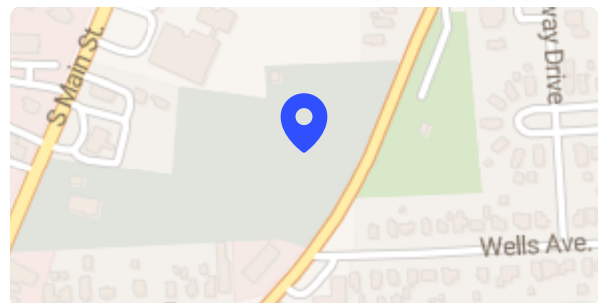

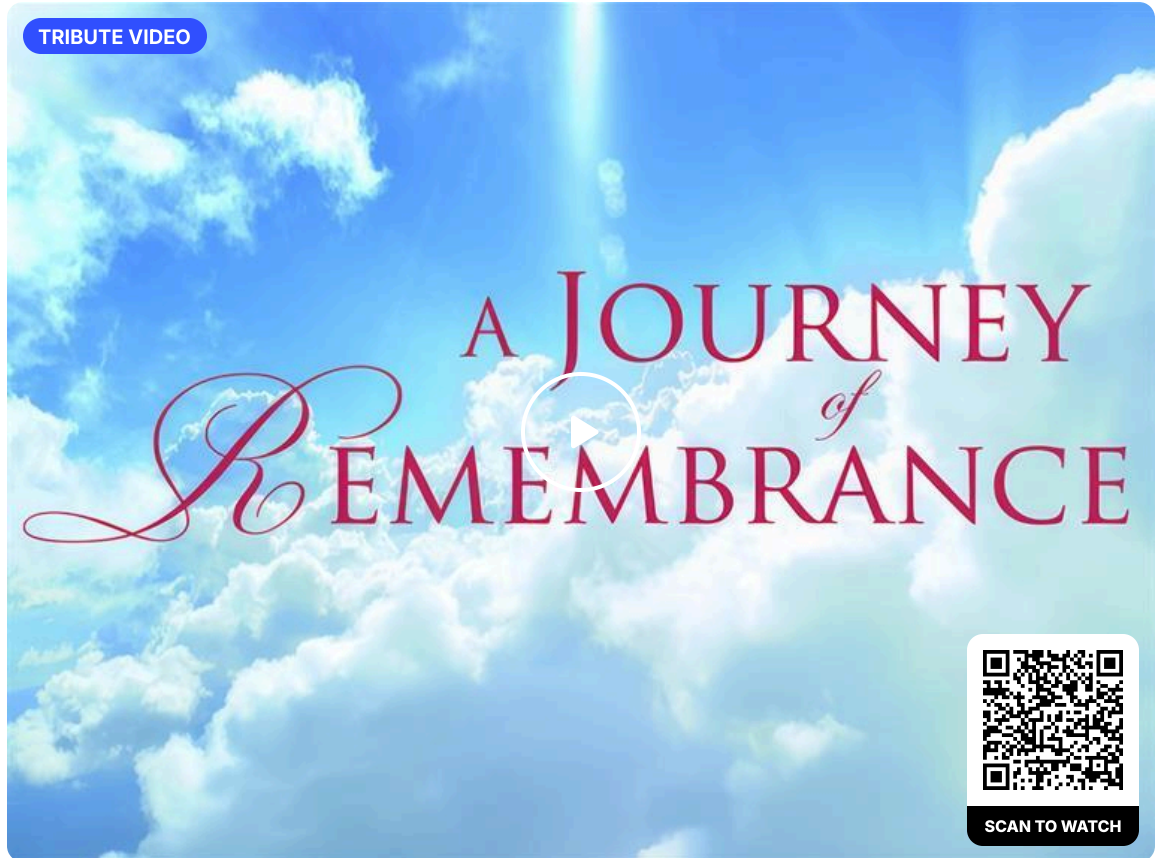
