Romeo G. "Butch" Hart, 68, of Minoa, passed away suddenly on Tuesday. A native of Massena, he resided in the Syracuse area for the past 50 years. He served with the U.S. Navy from 1960 to 1963. Romeo was employed by the Carrier Corporation, UTC Division for 28 years before his retirement. He was an avid collector of Baseball Cards. Romeo loved spending time with his family and grandchildren and especially made it a priority to help care for others before himself.

He was predeceased by his parents, Romeo J. and Margaret Hart and his brother, Roger. Romeo is survived by his loving wife of 48 years, Nancy R. (Romeo) Hart; two sons, Steven W. 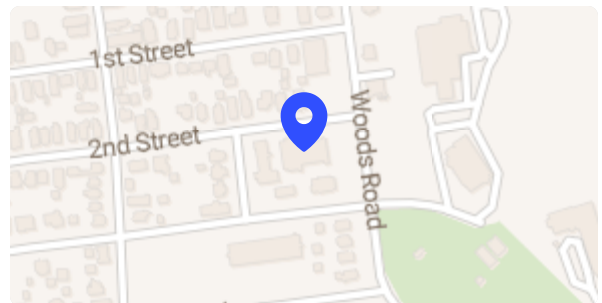
