Yolanda (Calabria) Rosati, 86, of Liverpool, passed away on Tuesday surrounded by her loving family. She was born in Syracuse, the daughter of the late Fredrick and Anna (Nestico) Calabria. Yolanda was employed by Easy Washer Company for seven years, Deluxe Check Printers for twenty years and then happily retired to enjoy traveling and spending time with family and friends.
