Rose A. Kleist, 85, of Syracuse, passed away on Sunday May 11, 2014. The daughter of the late Mario & Lena (DelGiorno) Linares. Rose attended North High School and was the owner of the "Rosalee Gift Shop" and "Truly Yours". She was a past president of the Assumption Academy Catholic School P.T.A., a member of the Altar & Rosary Society, and past president of St. Jude the Apostles. She was a trained opera singer, devoted Catholic, wife, mother and grandmother. She enjoyed spending time with her grandchildren and her great grandchildren whether it was sitting and talking, out shopping or sitting down to root for the N.Y. Yankees. Other than her parents she was predeceased by her grandson Sean Welch. Rose is survived by her husband Nicholas J. Kleist Sr., 2 daughters Helena (Michael) Welch of Granger, IN. 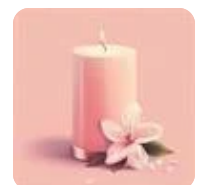

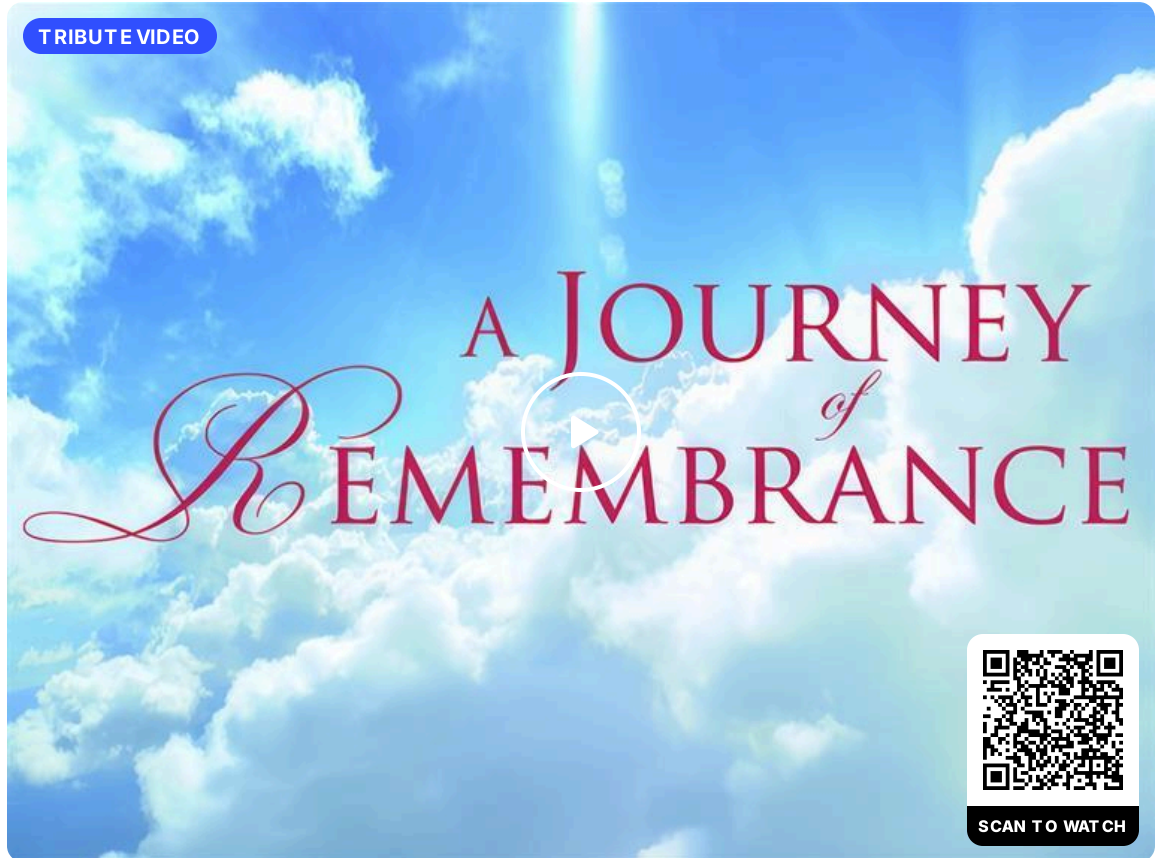
