Genevieve F. "Gen" Sansone, of Liverpool, passed away Tuesday surrounded by family at St. Joseph's Hospital. She was born in Reggio, Calabria, Italy and came to the United States in 1929. Gen retired as a Teaching Assistant with the Liverpool Central School District. As a licensed cosmetologist and beauty consultant, she was a member of the American Business Women's Association. Gen enjoyed playing cards, especially Pitch and Pinochle with family and friends. She also volunteered at the Francis House.

She was predeceased by her husband, Carl A. Foriero, father of her children, her husband later in life, Jack Sansone; three brothers, John, Patsy and Albert DeSalvo, three sisters, Josephine DiGregorio, Frances DeSalvo and Margaret Molella.

Gen is survived by three children, Carol (Buddy) Malone of Mississippi; Michelle D. 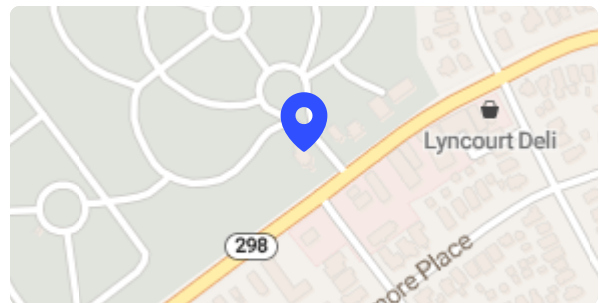

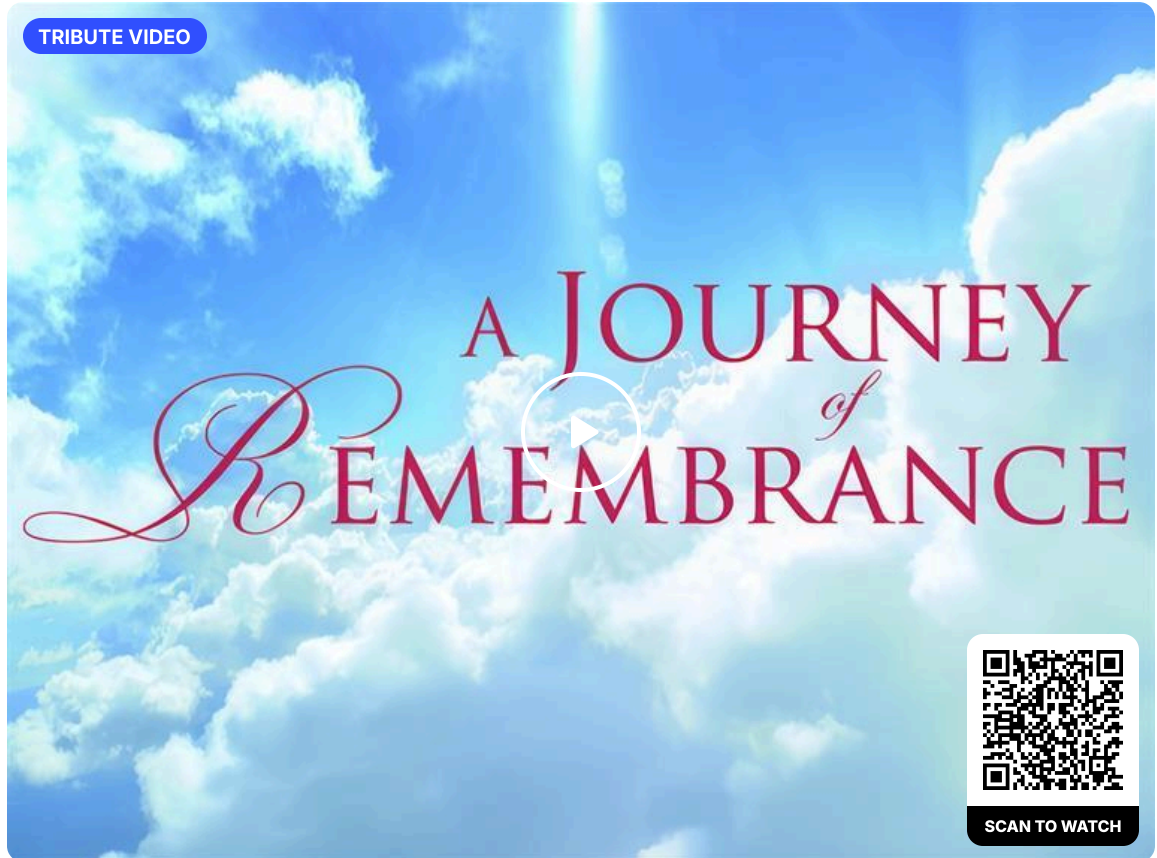
