Carmella R. (Cutri) Vercillo, 87, a life resident of Syracuse, passed away Friday, September 19th at home surrounded by her loving family. 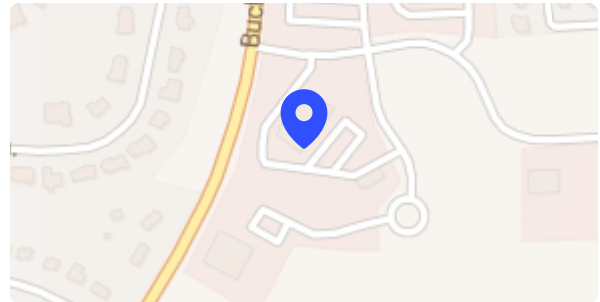

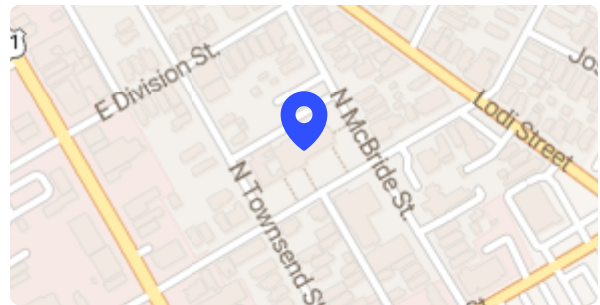

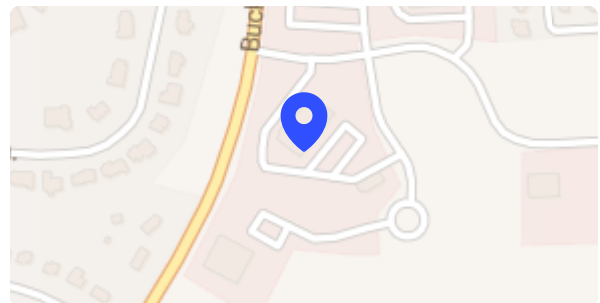
