Peter R. Moses, 62, of North Syracuse, NY passed away on June 15, 2011 at Crouse Hospital after a brief illness. His loving family was by his side. Peter was born and raised in Rochester, NY and in 1967 he and his family moved to Conesus Lake. He graduated from SUNY Oswego with a BS and Masters Degree in Education. For a number of years he taught at Lakeshore Elementary School and then went on to start his own business, "Moses Antiques". For the last 25 years, he participated in antique shows throughout New York and New England. His business was his life and he often commented on the many wonderful friends he made in his travels. He is predeceased by his father, David G. Moses. Peter is survived by his mother, Sally Moses of Geneseo, NY; brothers, John (Janis) Moses of East Syracuse, NY and Jim (Kathy) Moses of Bergen, NY; his special friend, Mollie Steele; best friends from Oswego and Le Moyne College; aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins. 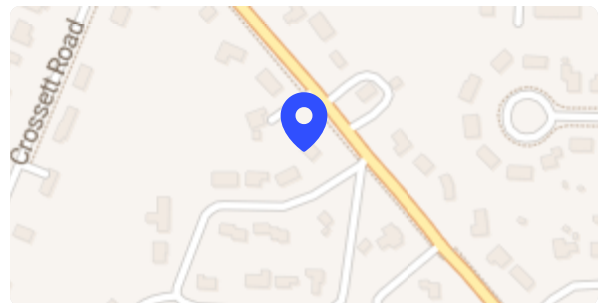
