## **Santina Sindoni**

AUG 12, 1921 - JAN 25, 2015

**S**antina Sindoni, 93, passed away Sunday, January 25, 2015 after a long illness. She was a lifetime resident of Syracuse, and a communicant of Our Lady of Pompei /St. Peter Church. She was also a member of the Pompei and Holy Trinity Senior Groups.

Aunt Tina, as she was fondly called, was very proud of her Italian heritage. She loved family events and holidays, and was always proud of all family member accomplishments.

Santina began her career at Markson's Furniture Store. She retired from the City of Syracuse, Department of Finance Bureau of Accounts.

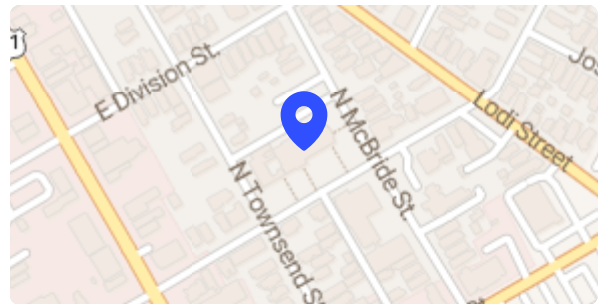

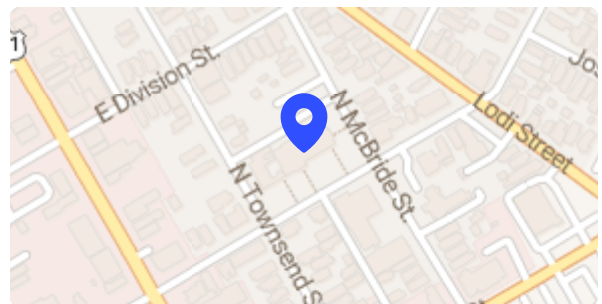

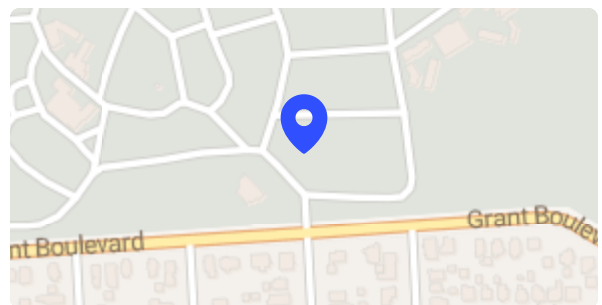
