**J**oseph Thomas Anesi, 83, of Liverpool, NY, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, April 22, 2015 at the Francis House. He was born on June 12, 1931, in Syracuse, NY to the late Jenny (Centritta) and Nicholas Annesi. Joseph served with the US Air Force from 1948-1952 and was Honorably Discharged as Staff Sergeant. He retired in 1986 as an engineer for Carrier Corporation in Syracuse, NY after 34 years of service.

He was predeceased by his wife of 32 years, Joan (Sarno) Anesi in 1986 and his siblings, John Annesi and Mary Titone.

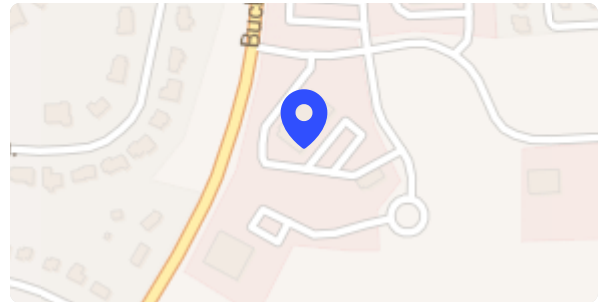

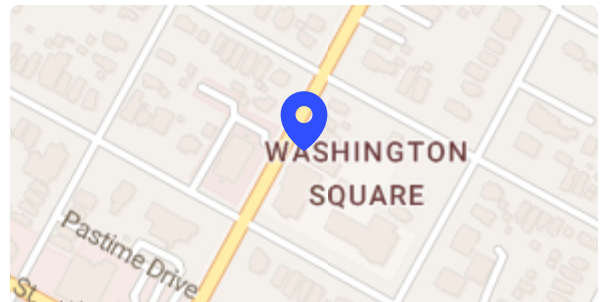

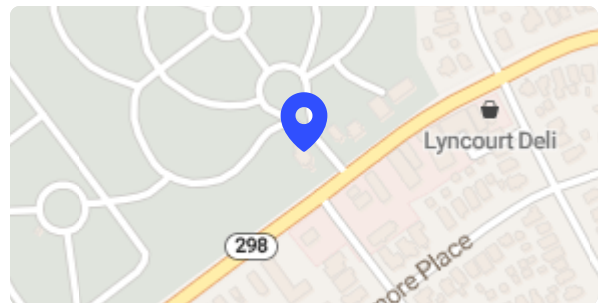
