## **Anthony Ianno**

MAY 3, 1923 - SEP 30, 2011

**A**nthony Ianno, 88, of North Syracuse, passed away on Friday at St. Joseph's Hospital. He was born in San Giovanni Reggio Calabria Italy and resided in the Syracuse area since 1936. Anthony served with the US Army during WWII. He was the owner and operator of Anthony Ianno Apples and then Tony and Grace's Farm Stand, Rt. 31 and Rt. 57. Anthony was a member of the Italian American Athletic Club, the Lion's Club and the VFW Post 951.
