Anthony Proietta, 92, of Liverpool, passed away peacefully in his home on Monday, November 2, 2015. He was born in Syracuse on November 24, 1922. Anthony was a World War II combat veteran, serving with the 45th Infantry Division/645th Tank Destroyer Battalion. Anthony was chosen as a Flag Barer for the 50th Anniversary of the Invasion of Anzio and recently joined other WWII veterans on an Honor Flight to Washington, D.C.

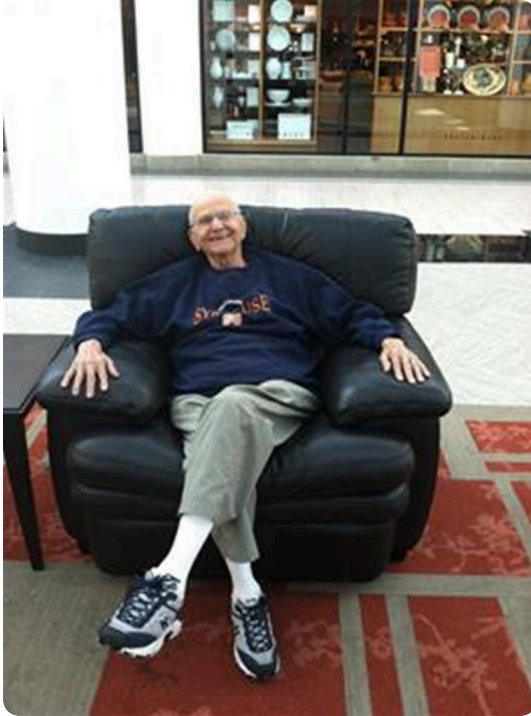
