Joseph A. Donardo, 92, of Liverpool, passed away Friday in the James Square Health and Rehabilitation Center surrounded by his loving family. A life resident of the Syracuse area, he was an Army Veteran of World War II and a 4th Degree Member of the Knights of Columbus, Bishop Curley Council #3717. Joe had been employed by Acme Markets for 30 years before his retirement. A great athlete, he had received many awards as a "Fastpitch" softball pitcher and was an accomplished and avid bowler. He was also very active with the "Happy Times Club" at St. Rose of Lima Church where he was also a communicant. 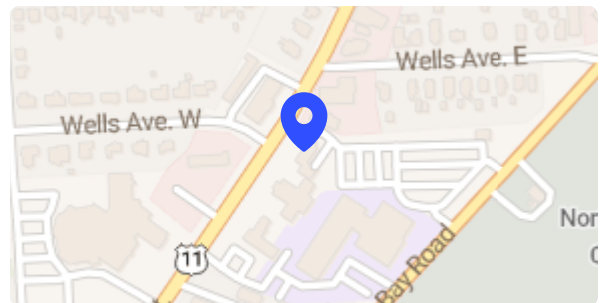
