James F. "Moose" Hoffsher, 88, of North Syracuse, passed away peacefully on Thursday at home with his wife by his side after a brief illness. He was born on February 27, 1927 and grew up on the north side of Syracuse. James served with the US Army during World War II. He graduated from Assumption Academy and was a parishioner of Assumption Church. James was employed by New York Telephone, retiring with Verizon after 35 years of service in 1985. He was a kind and loving man with a strong faith who enjoyed being with his family.

He was predeceased by his mother, Mary (Argy) Hoffsher in 1979 and his father, Frederick Hoffsher in 1958; brother, Donald W. Hoffsher, Sr. in 1985; sister, MaryAnn LaFleur in 2005; beloved niece, Susan Salerno in 1990 who he loved as a daughter.

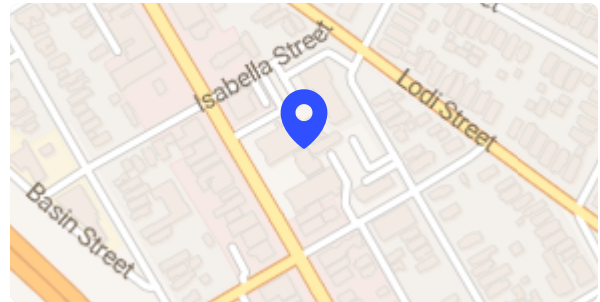

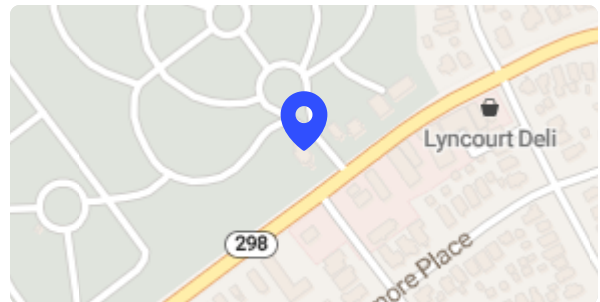
