Gail (Olvert) Caster, 77, of Liverpool, passed away Wednesday at St. Joseph's Hospital. She was born in Watertown, NY, and graduated from Watertown High School in 1957. Gail married Charles Caster in 1959. She graduated as an LPN and worked at St. Joseph's Hospital, retiring after 27 years of service. Gail volunteered at Immaculate Heart of Mary Church and the Francis House and was also involved with the girl scouts. She loved gardening, ceramics, and sitting beside an ocean on a sandy beach. Gail was very proud of her children and grandchildren.
