Joseph G. Milazzo, 72, of Syracuse, passed away suddenly on Saturday at his home. He was born in Syracuse, the son of Santo and Ida Milazzo. Joseph served with the U.S. Marines. He was a sheet metal worker with Joseph Cashier Company for 20 years and then founded his own business, CMP Sheet Metal Inc., for 20 years before retiring. Joseph was a proud and active member of the Holy Name Society at Our Lady of Pompei Church and the Italian American Athletic Club. He enjoyed his daily walks, playing cards, golf and family Wildwood vacations with the Pompeian Group. Joseph also enjoyed being a spectator at his grandchildren's activities and most of all, being a devoted husband, father and "PAPA". He was predeceased by his brothers, Matthew and Stephen Milazzo and sister, Fannie Calogero. Joseph is survived by his loving wife of 51 years, Barbara A. (Manzi) Milazzo; three daughters, Sharon M. 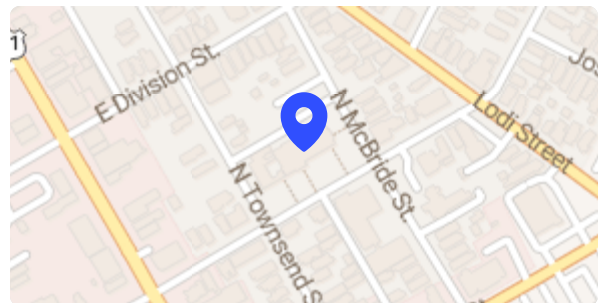
