## **Lucille "Lucy" (Nesci) Hall**

DEC 13, 1938 - OCT 29, 2017

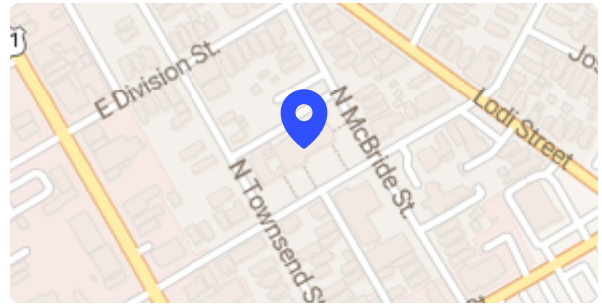

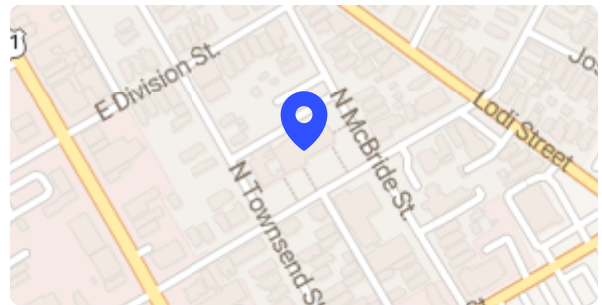
