**L**aurice T. Bonin, 86, went to be with the Lord on March 2, 2018. She was born in Utica NY, the daughter of the late Jalil and Phillipine (Boustany) Altongy. Laurice graduated from Becker College in Worcester, MA with an Associate's Degree in Secretarial Science. Upon graduation, Laurice was employed by General Electric where she met her husband of almost 60 years, Gilbert Charles Bonin. Laurice continued her career working for the North Syracuse Central School District for 20 fulfilling years as a Teacher's Aide. Laurice was a member of St. Rose of Lima Church and the Altar Rosary Society. She had a strong devotion to the Blessed Mother and believed in the power of the rosary and prayer.

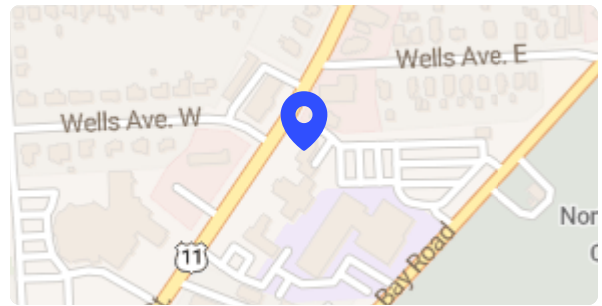

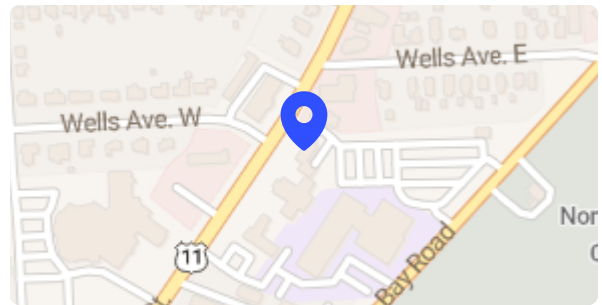
