## **Terry L. Sharpe**

**T**erry L. Sharpe, 65, of Syracuse, passed away on Sunday, July 15, 2018 at St. Joseph's Hospital surrounded by his family and cherished grandchildren, Chase and Avery. Terry was born in Massena, NY, son of Philip and Vivian (Sellars) Sharpe.

Terry was a U.S. Air Force veteran, and an accomplished cook at local restaurants around Syracuse, including Partners Restaurant, Gardenview Diner and the American Diner.
