Fanny (Alteri) Lumia passed away on November 28, 2018 at the age of 95. Fanny, the daughter of Frank and Eugenia (Calvarese) Alteri was born in Syracuse on October 15, 1923 and lived here most of her life. She married Vincent Lumia in 1946 and was predeceased by him in 2000. In 2013 Fanny moved to Ballston Lake, NY to live with her daughter and son-in-law, Norma and Lawrence Sowers.

Mrs. Lumia worked at the Muench Kreuzer Candle Company for many years. During her employment she was a shop steward and was elected as the union president.

In addition to her parents and her husband, she was predeceased by her siblings: Mary Tucci, Joseph, Anthony, Michael, Louis and Frank.

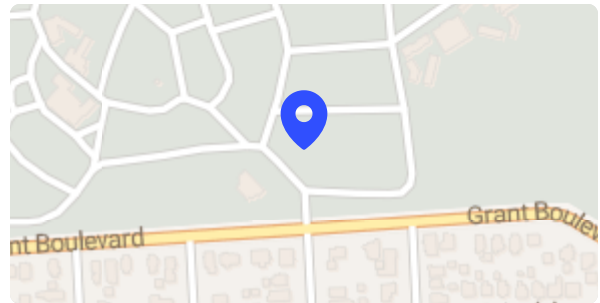
