Patsy E. Campagna, Sr., 89, of Syracuse, son of the late Ernesto Giuseppe and Wilma passed away Wednesday, December 5, 2018.

He was born in Syracuse and was a proud U.S. Marine Corps. veteran of the Korean Conflict. Patsy retired as Postmaster of Camillus in 1984. He was a communicant of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church and St. Daniel's Catholic Church.

He was predeceased by his sister, Vincenza; brothers, Santo, Edwardo, Antonio, Roberto (Emanuel) and his oldest son, Pat Jr.

Patsy leaves behind his loving wife of 67 years, Annunziata "Nancy" (Ventre); his sons, Tommaso (Diane) and Ernesto (Terry); his daughter-in-law, Nancy and his youngest brother, Giovanni. Also, grandchildren, great-grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.

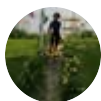
