Victor R. Diorio, 81, of North Syracuse, passed away peacefully on March 24, 2019 at Upstate University Hospital surrounded by his loving family. He was born in Syracuse to the late Michael and Mary (Cannone) Diorio. He served in the Air National Guard following his graduation from North High School. Victor worked for the Syracuse Police Department as a Patrol Officer and Special Investigator, retiring in 1986. He was a member of the Syracuse Police Fraternal Association.

Besides his parents, he is also predeceased by his sister, Madeline Delcioppo.

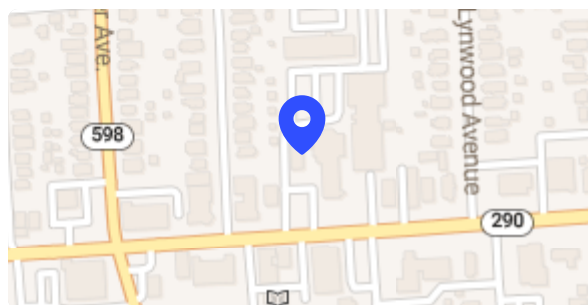
