Nancy (Settineri) Storto, 94, of Syracuse, passed away peacefully at home on May 6, 2019 surrounded by her loving family. 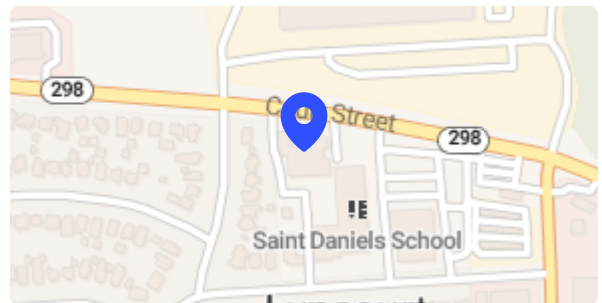
