She graduated from Scranton Technical High School and worked for the Scranton Diocese of the Roman Catholic Church.

Louise married her husband Edward on October 20, 1956 moving to Syracuse, NY and finally settling in Liverpool, NY in 1959. When her three children were all in school, she began working for the Liverpool School District and continued for many years in a variety of roles. But her greatest role was mother and grandmother. 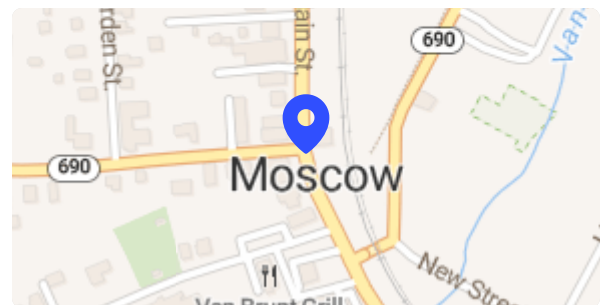

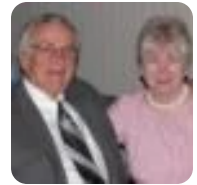
