Rose Marie Camarda, 72, retired Syracuse Science Teacher, left us to teach in that Big School in the Sky. Rose will always be in the mind and hearts of her students. She passed away on November 16, 2019 at home with her family by her side. She graduated from Henninger, Brockport and Syracuse University. Rose made many things happen for her students; she brought Moon Rocks to the classroom and made weather systems a fun learning experience. Rose was an Atmospheric Resource Teacher; on May 12, 1998, the Syracuse Board of Education honored her for the Technology Club Outstanding Teacher Award, and she also received the Earth Science Teacher of the Year Award, among many other rewards. Rose enjoyed sports and coached School Basketball and Softball; outside of school, she was a softball umpire.

She is predeceased by her parents, Nicholas and Laura Camarda; three brothers, Harold, Dan and Nick. Rose is survived by her friend and companion, Janice Lorraine; two brothers, Tim (Linda) Camarda and Tom (Michelle) Camarda; along with many aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, and her Beloved Fur Baby, Buster.

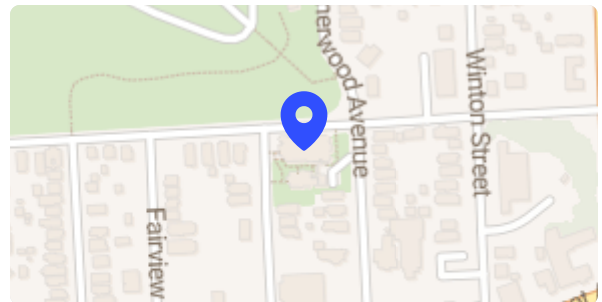

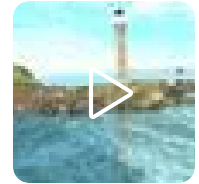
