**K**arl M. DeCerce, 78, of Liverpool, passed away on Friday at St. Joseph's Hospital. He was born in Syracuse, son of the late Frank and Sadone (Hansen) DeCerce. Karl was a U.S. Navy veteran and was employed for more than 20 years at Young and Franklin in Liverpool. Karl then went on to work at Welch Allyn for many years, developing a patent for the self-directing endoscope. He was predeceased by his brother, Garrett DeCerce. Karl is survived by his loving wife of 46 years, Maggie (Sheridan) DeCerce; daughters, Deirdre (John) Fisher; Adrienne DeCerce; Lennie DeCerce (Shawn Cole); grandsons, Christopher and Matthew Fisher.
