## **Frank P. Scarcella**

JUL 19, 1927 - FEB 12, 2020

**S**adly, Frank P. Scarcella, 92, passed away on February 12, 2020 in Hallandale, Florida. He was born in Palmi, Italy on July 19, 1927 to Carmella and Rocco Scarcella. Frank moved to Syracuse in 1951 and married Carmella on July 3, 1954. He retired from Syracuse Parks and Recreation after 30 years working as a heavy machine operator. He also spent many years working at the NYS Fair, War Memorial, Syracuse Civic Center, and Sky Chiefs Stadium.

Frank was known for his love of gardening, winemaking, especially with his grandson Rocco, and entertaining. He loved traveling to Florida every winter. Frank was happiest when he was surrounded by friends and family. He will be truly missed by all.

In addition to his parents, he is predeceased by his sister, Antoinette (Scarcella) Pugliese.

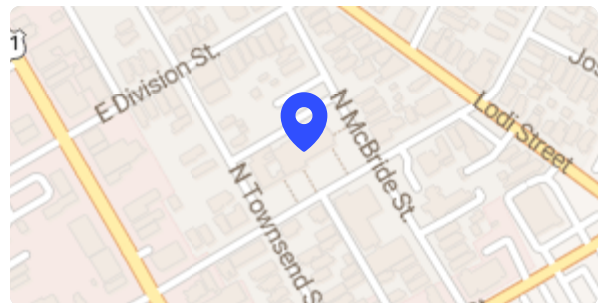

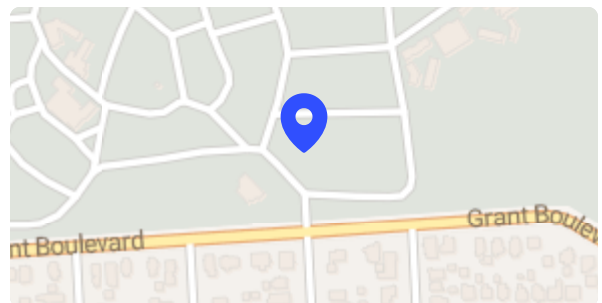

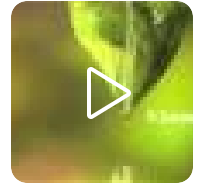
