Joseph Siracusa, 88, of Syracuse, passed away on Friday, February 14, 2020 at St. Joseph's Hospital. He was born in Geneva, NY son of the late Liborio and Sandina (Scarsone) Siracusa and was a U.S. Army veteran. Joe was a graduate of SU College of Law in 1960 and was an attorney in Syracuse for many years as well as a teacher of Criminal Justice at OCC. 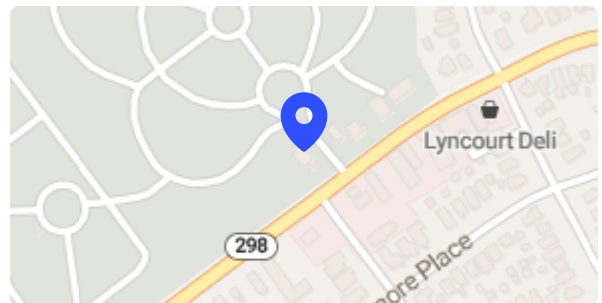
