**D**avid J. Baichi, 44, of Solvay, passed away unexpectedly on March 16, 2020 after sudden heart complications. David was born in Syracuse and graduated from Solvay High School later obtaining his associates degree from O.C.C. David was employed as a Police Officer with the Solvay Police Department. 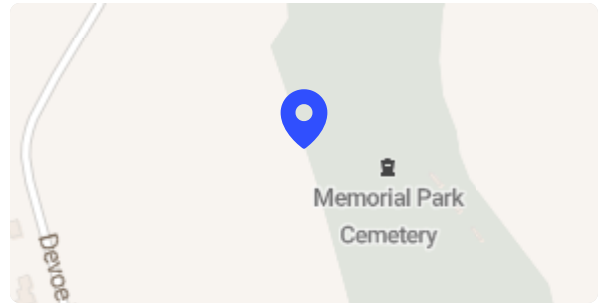

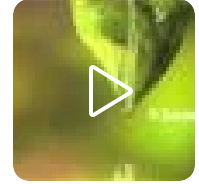

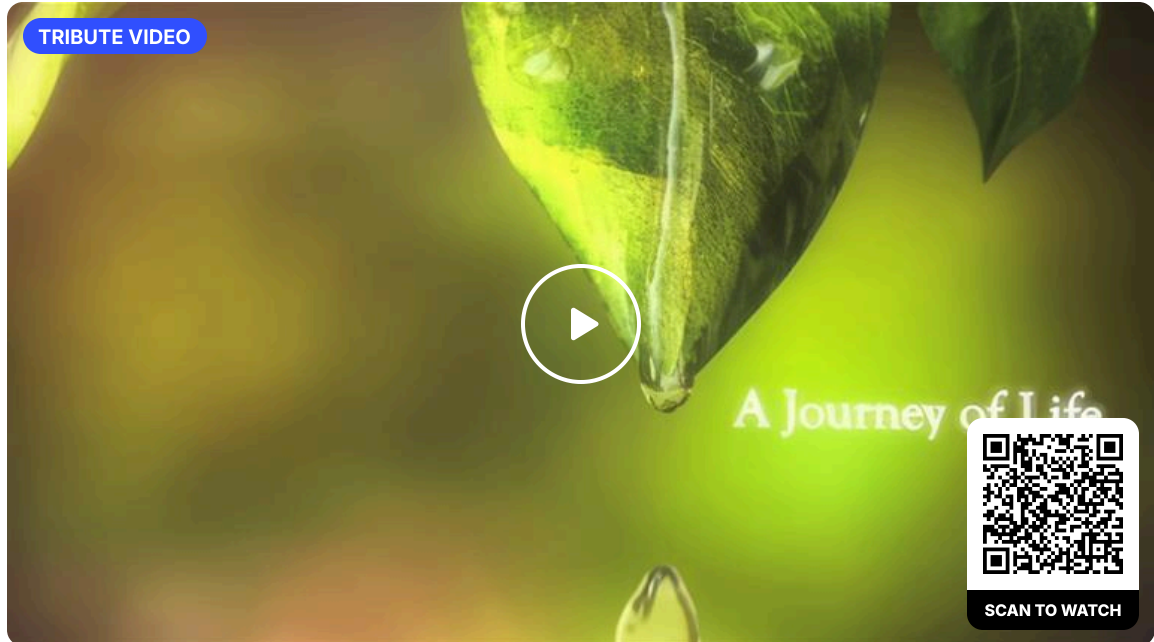
