Mary (Walsh) Doherty, 90, passed away peacefully on April 18, 2020 surrounded by her loving family. Her graceful and accepting spirit were gifts she gave to everyone she met. This grace was most certainly a result of her deep faith. She was a devout Catholic and could always be seen carrying a pair of rosary beads and saying her prayers. She was a parishioner of St. Rose of Lima Church in North Syracuse. Mary was born in Chelsea, MA and graduated from Girls Catholic High School in Malden, MA. She married Frank Doherty in 1953, and they ultimately settled in North Syracuse to raise their five children. Their younger years were spent on the magical Elm Street where all members of the Doherty family made life-long relationships. She stayed at home with her five kids until they were all in school.

She worked several jobs, but the one she was most proud of and retired from was the Onondaga County District Attorney's Office where she worked as a secretary for 15 years. She loved her co-workers and believed their work was inspiring and important. However, Mary's favorite "job" was that of mother and grandmother. Mary was happiest when surrounded by her kids and grandkids. The large, numerous family celebrations always included Mary in the kitchen making a vat of gravy and mashed potatoes to serve the family members who were "patiently" waiting to eat. Mary's ever-present faith carried her through difficult times including the sudden death of her mother when Mary was only 19 years old. As she quickly became the matriarch of the family, she developed a special bond with her younger sister Pat that would continue until the day Mary died. Mary also withstood the devastating loss of her beloved first-born son, Kevin. She would be quick to share stories of her appreciation of Kevin being a helpful older brother to Brian, Terence, Mary Anne and Jeanne Anne.

After the death of her husband in 2015, Mary found great comfort in the camaraderie at Parkrose Estates where she enjoyed working on her puzzles and developing friendships with the staff and residents. Even towards the end of her life, her beautiful blue eyes would light up the minute she

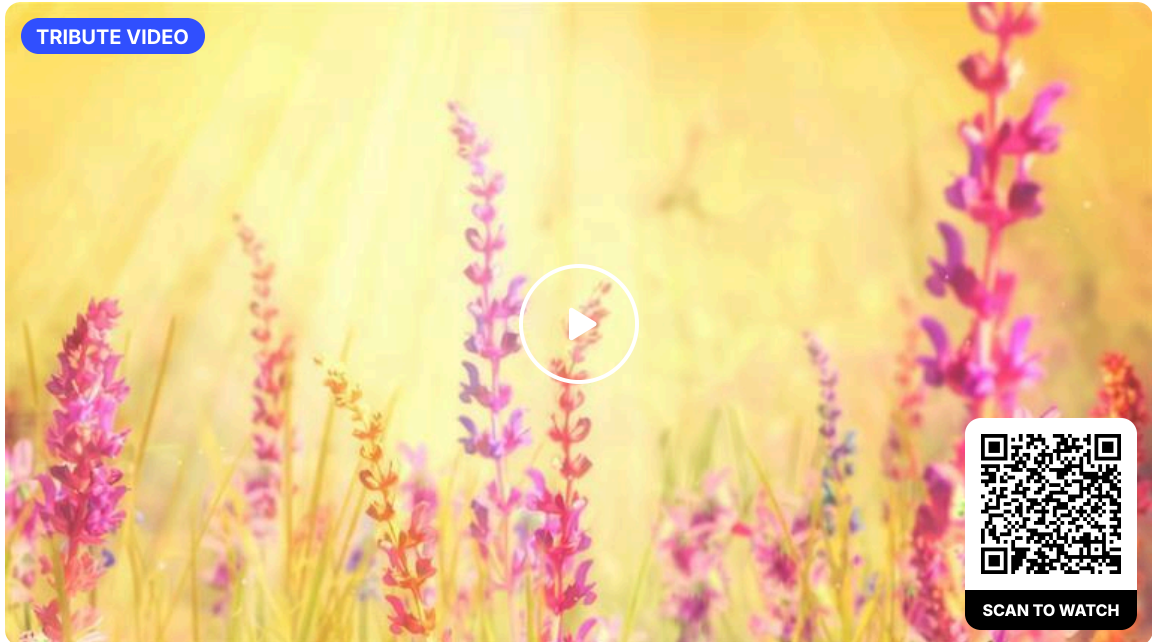
