Private burial will take place in Holy Trinity Cemetery in Utica. A celebration of life will be planned for the spring of 2021.




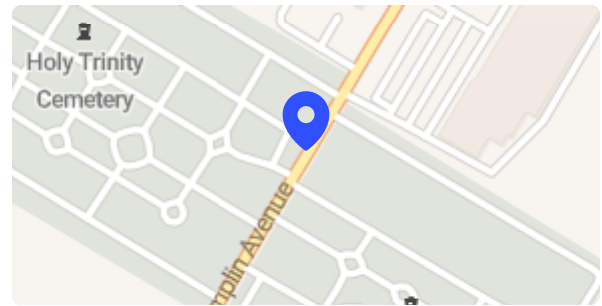
