Vincent Lupo, 86, of Syracuse, passed away peacefully at Francis House on November 6, 2020. He was born in Comiso, Sicily, Italy to the late Giuseppe and Angela (DiFalco) Lupo. Vince worked for many years as a book binder at Hall and McChesney and later at the Onondaga County Clerk's Office in the same capacity. He also volunteered for over 20 years at St. Joseph's Hospital. Vince enjoyed cooking and gardening and was an avid reader.

In addition to his parents, he is predeceased by his brother, Joseph Lupo and his sister, Stella Gianni.

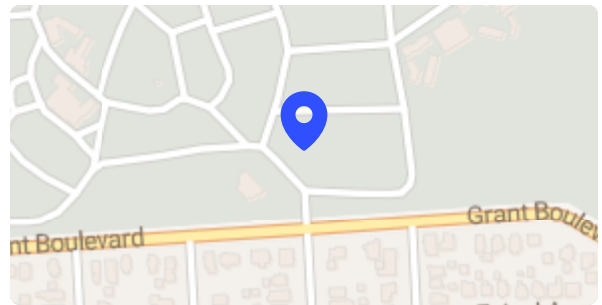
