**R**obert J. Brown, 72, of Cicero, passed away peacefully at home on Sunday, December 13, 2020. He was born in North Tarrytown, NY (Sleepy Hollow) to the late Kenneth and Eleanor (Sing) Brown and was a 1966 graduate of Sleepy Hollow High School. Upon graduation, Bob went on to receive his Bachelor of Science degree from SUNY Brockport in 1972 and his Master's in Clinical Psychology from Central Michigan University in 1977. He went on to work for the Central Michigan Health Clinic in Big Rapids, MI and was an instructor for the Central Michigan graduate program. Bob also worked at the Easter Seal Rehab Center in Stamford, CT and was the vice president of Yost EAP in Liverpool and president of Applied Human Science.
