Louis O. Eber, Jr., 93, of Liverpool, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by his loving family and caregivers on Wednesday, September 15, 2021. Born in Lyndhurst, NJ to the late Ellen (King) and Louis O. Eber, Sr., he graduated with a BS degree in electrical engineering from Stevens Institutes of Technology and with a master's degree in electrical engineering from Syracuse University and served in the US Navy. Louis worked nearly 50 dedicated years as an electrical engineer for General Electric and was part of the Over the Horizon Radar Program. Upon his retirement, Louis was a dedicated volunteer for AARP Central NY as a Tax Coordinator. He enjoyed sailing, traveling, and listening to opera music.

In addition to his parents, Louis was predeceased by his wife of 55 years, D. Marie Eber in 2013; and his sister, Charlotte Eber in 2011.

Louis is survived by his son, James W. Eber (Gordon Parkhurst), and daughter, Ellen M. Eber.

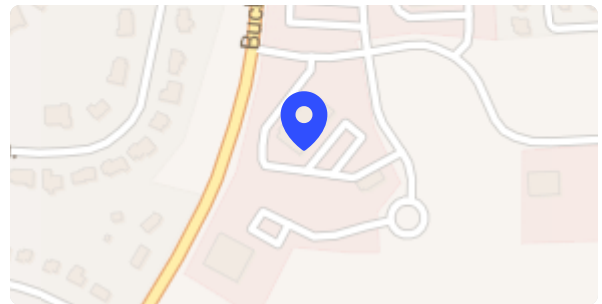

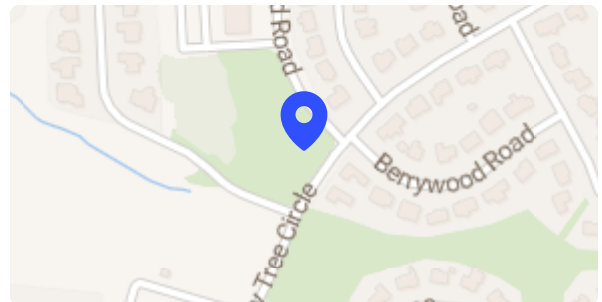

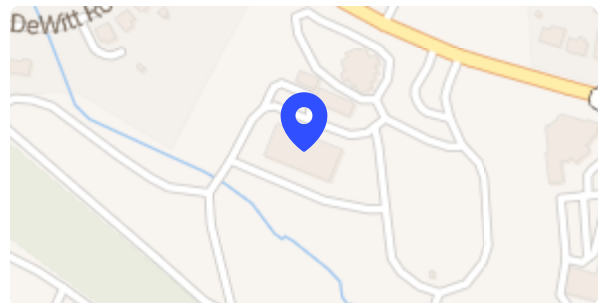
