Vincent Caracci, Jr., 91, of Syracuse, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, November 3, 2021 at the Cottages at Garden Grove. He was born in Syracuse to the late Vincent Sr. and Rose (Giaruzzo) Caracci. Vincent retired from the Herald-Journal Newspaper after 37 dedicated years working as a pressman. As a proud US Navy Veteran, he was a Chartered Member of the Fleet Reserve Association and was very active in his involvement.

Besides his parents, he is predeceased by his wife, Rosemary (Alibrandi) Caracci and his brother, Anthony Caracci.

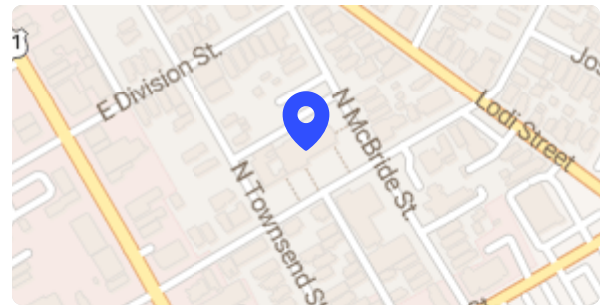

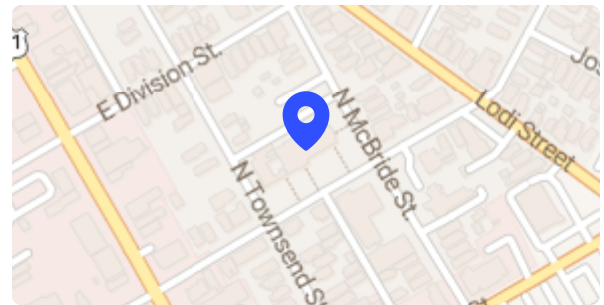

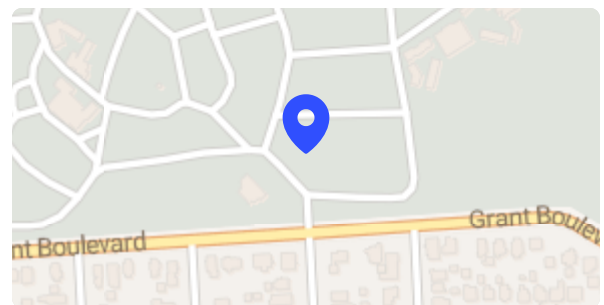
