On November 24, 2021, Thomas F. Maley passed from this world to his heavenly reward. He was born to Frank and Pearl Maley in Syracuse, NY on May 12, 1942. Thomas was a beloved son, brother, husband, father, and grandfather. He graduated from Christian Brothers Academy, Ithaca College (BFA), and Syracuse University (MFA). He taught in the Syracuse Public Schools, producing Broadway plays with teenagers while parenting two children of his own.
