**P**atricia (Bowman) Russo, 74, of Fayetteville, passed away peacefully at home on January 19, 2022, surrounded by her loving family. Patricia was born in Syracuse to the late Francis and Mary Ellen (McCormick) Bowman. She was a parishioner of Holy Cross Church.

Patty grew up on the North Side of Syracuse and was a lifelong resident of the Syracuse area. She was the tenth of 12 children and graduated from St. Vincent's DePaul High School. She married her high school sweetheart on her birthday in 1970 and shared the next 51 years together. They raised two children who, guided by her love, devotion, and wisdom, would grow up to become an attorney and cardio thoracic surgeon. Her impact on their lives is immeasurable and the lessons she instilled in them will live forever.

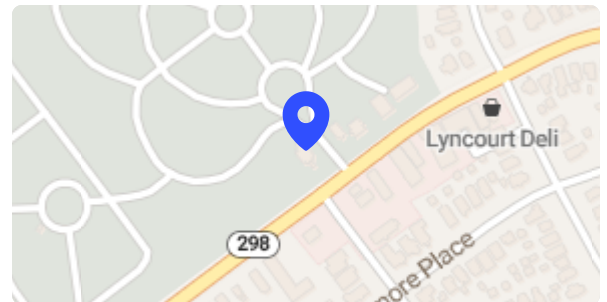

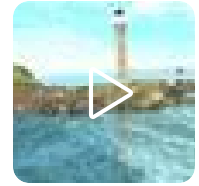
