Peter L. "Pete" Bailey, 75, of Cicero, passed away peacefully on Friday, March 4, 2022, at Francis House surrounded by his loving family. He was born in Syracuse to the late Ken and Lelia "Judy" (Dunham) Bailey. Pete was a U.S. Navy Veteran serving as a gunner's mate aboard the USS Leary between 1968-1972. He attended Le Moyne College, Syracuse University, and the FBI National Academy, culminating in a career with the Onondaga County Sheriff's Office that spanned over 38 years until his retirement as captain. He enjoyed the arts, notably photography and literature, and loved learning about history and traveling with his family.

In addition to his parents, Pete is predeceased by his wife, Linda (Metzgar) Bailey.
