Joseph A. Volpe, 70, of Cicero, NY, passed away suddenly at home on March 14, 2022. He was born in Rome, NY, son of the late Egidio and Annette Volpe, and graduated from Rome Free Academy in 1969 and SUNY Oswego in 1973. Joseph retired from Constellations Nuclear. He was Coach and President of Cicero Falcons Pop Warner Football for over 20 years where the field house is named after him in honor of his years of service. Joseph loved his weekly nights of pitch with his son and wife and taking his chances at the casino. Most importantly, he loved spending time with his family and friends. 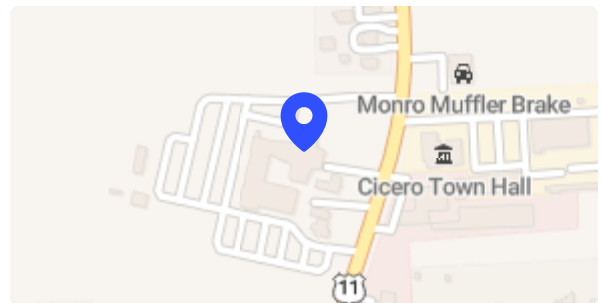
