Ralph B. Busco, 91, of Syracuse, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, April 12, 2022, in the home he built over 65 years ago. Born in Syracuse to the late Mary (DiPierco) and Joseph Busco, he was a journeyman tool & die maker at General Motors, retiring after 42 dedicated years. Ralph was a gardener and woodworker, but most of all, he was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. He enjoyed spending time with his family and going out to dinner.

Along with his parents, Ralph was predeceased by his beloved wife, Grace, in 2016; his cherished daughter, Cynthia Cappoletti, in 2000; as well as 3 sisters.

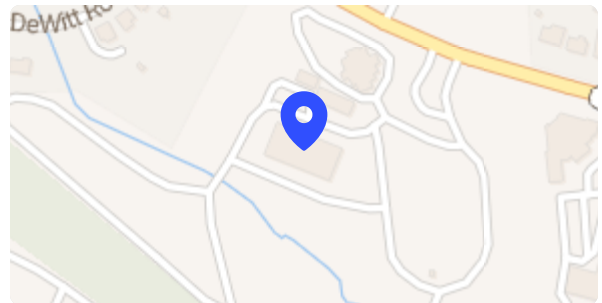

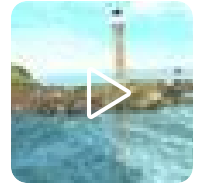
