Michael Canestrare, 83, of Syracuse, passed away peacefully Wednesday, April 13, 2022, at home with his loving family by his side. Born in Syracuse to the late Genevieve (Guinto) and Michael D. Canestrare, he was a self-employed graphic designer and artist at his company, Canestrare Graphics. Michael was an avid football fan and enjoyed golf, he was the president of the Rogues Roost Golf League for 15 years. He enjoyed traveling, especially to Aruba, his wine club, and his Sunday Fundays with family and friends.

Along with his parents, Michael is predeceased by his siblings, Johanna Duell, in 2021, and Ronald Canestrare, in 2015.

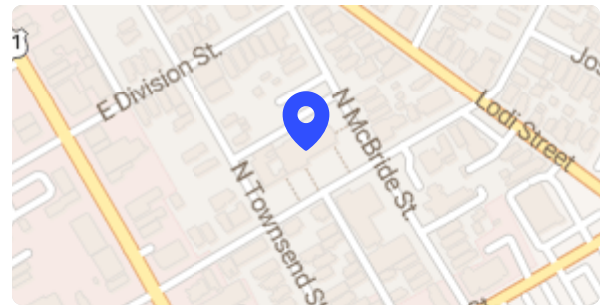

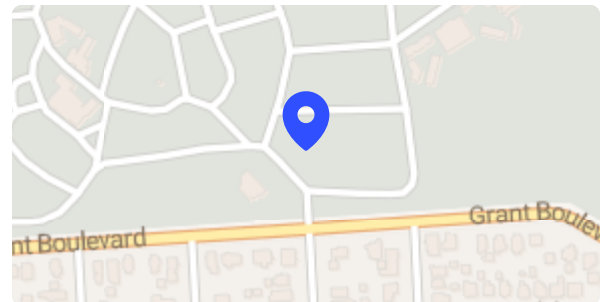
