## **Samuel Bovalino**

**S**amuel Bovalino, 106, of Syracuse, passed away June 13, 2022, at Crouse Hospital. He was born in Syracuse, son of the late Dominick and Julia Bovalino. Sam retired from Kilian Manufacturing Company after many dedicated years. He was an avid NY Yankees fan; he also enjoyed playing cards, playing the drums, and walking for exercise.
