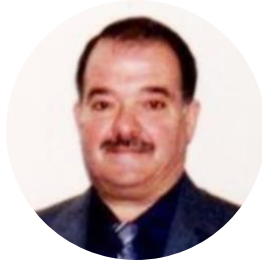

## **Anthony A. Tartaglia**

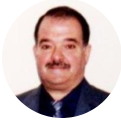
JUN 18, 1939 - NOV 5, 2022

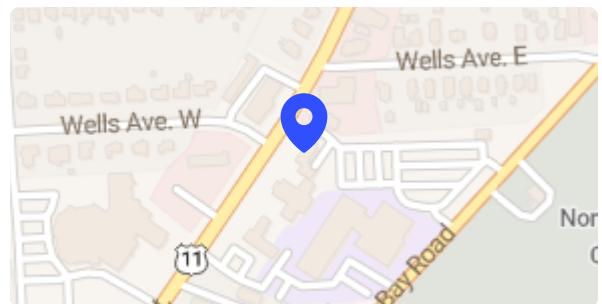

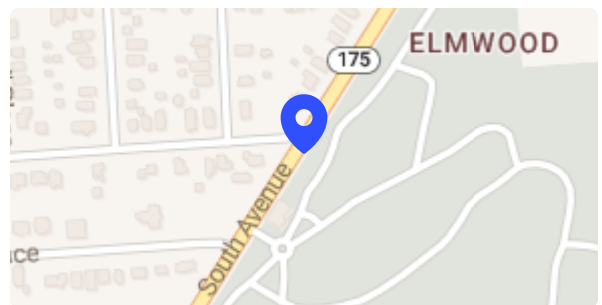

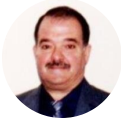
