Deana R. (Rivito) Gaiser, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother passed away peacefully on Sunday, November 20, 2022 at the age of 85. She was born in Syracuse to the late Santo and Brunetta Rivito and graduated from North High School in 1955 and enjoyed being a Pompeian Player. Deana was the President of the North Syracuse Lionettes, Mistress of Ceremonies for the Miss North Syracuse Pageant, a member of the Clay Republican Committee for many years, as well as a past member of the North Syracuse Fire Department Auxiliary. She was a real estate agent for 30 years and an active parishioner of St. Rose of Lima Church. 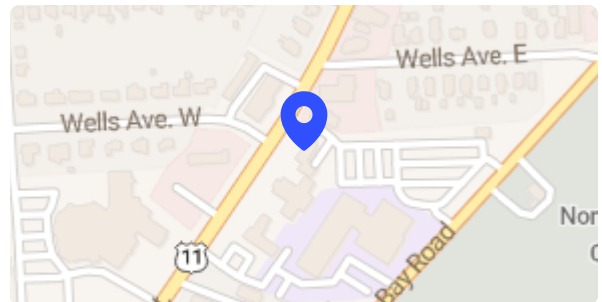

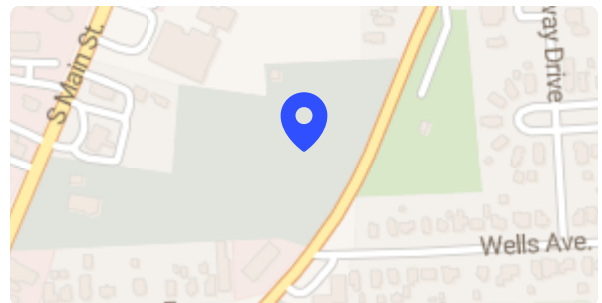
