# **Anthony "Tony" Cornacchione**

**A**nthony "Tony" Cornacchione, 98 1/2, of Liverpool, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, November 29, 2022. Tony was born in Syracuse to the late Sam and Virginia (DiPardo) Cornacchione. He worked as a tool maker for the Carrier Corp. for 41 years, retiring in 1988 and he served in the United States Navy. A true handyman, Tony could fix anything, but his greatest joy was interacting with his grandchildren; they loved his childlike ways of playing with them.

In addition to his parents, Tony is predeceased by his wife, Norma (Varano) Cornacchione this past August; his brothers, Cosmo, Sam, and Mario Cornacchione; his sisters, Antoinette Cornacchione, Josephine Humeniuk, and Anne Bleem.

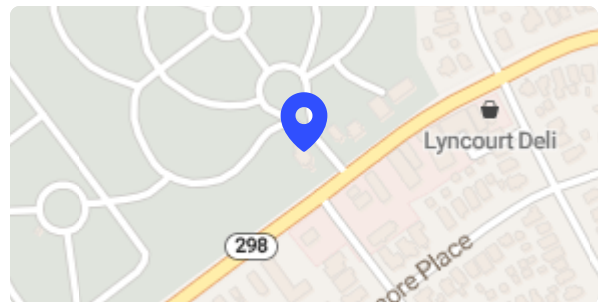
